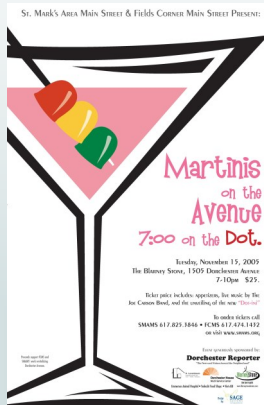


Types of Projects
